Worship

The attendance stats for worship only include the English services. We currently have 248 baptized. Of those, 198 primarily attend the English services, 31 primarily attend Nuer services and 19 primarily attend Kunama services. Perhaps attendance at Nuer and Kunama services will be kept in the future. What this means for the English services is that YTD 112 out of 198 attend on a given Sunday (57%). We could improve this by removing inactive members from membership or by encouraging each other to receive God's gifts of forgiveness, faith and salvation through the means of grace more often. "Let us encourage one another – and all the more as you see the Day approaching" (Hebrews 10:25).

Christian Education

Sunday School, Sunday Bible class, and Wednesday Bible class began in September. Campus Ministry at Drake resumes after a couple of years. It will be held on Mondays at 7 pm. Catechism has 10 students enrolled.

Evangelism


I will accompany Luke to an Asian Ministry meeting at the Seminary October 3-4.
